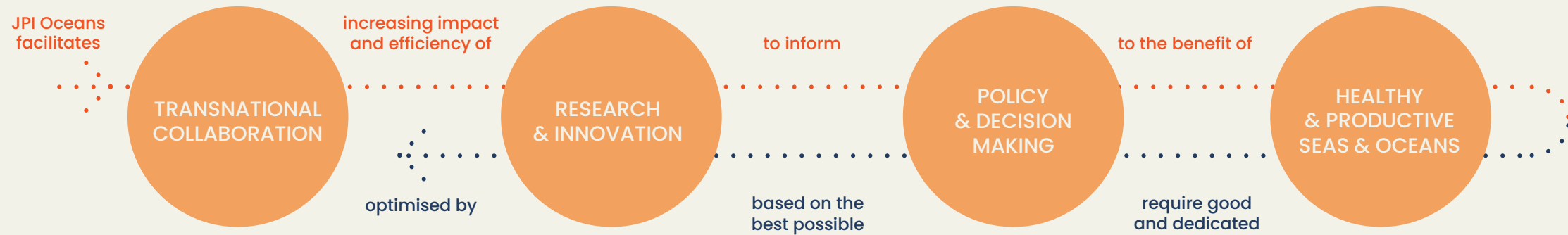
# Strategic role of JPI Oceans
